Pastor Dave's Corner:

I can't believe after three years, I'm still surprised how quickly Lent and Easter follow Advent and Christmas. We're hardly past Christmas and the New Year and Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of Lent, is less than a month away.

Normally, I would have something to say about preparing for Lent, but instead, I'd like to take this time to update you on what our Catalyst Teams at Poplar Springs and Jennings Chapel have been doing. Some of the opportunities you'll see in this issue are a result of their hard work and they'll need everyone's help to make them fruitful.

After 8 months of online learning, looking at demographic data, reviewing our skills and resources, talking with folks in our communities, meetings with Kay Kotan, our Synergist, and much prayer, the Catalyst teams have discerned how we might be called to reach out to our neighbors in the Woodbine, Mt. Airy, and Lisbon communities. We think our passions to socialize, to fellowship, and help others, along with our gifts for event and volunteer management, uniquely position us to do amazing things for God in our communities.

Both Catalyst Teams sense that God is calling us to improve the quality of life and well-being of those in our surrounding community. Our calling, we might say our mission focus, is broad and allows a lot of room for innovative ideas that the Holy Spirit might put on our hearts. Drawing on our one-on-one conversations with folks in the community and through other data, the teams were challenged to discern how God might be calling us to address a specific need in the community. Jennings Chapel team believes we are called to improve the quality of life by increasing a sense of belonging amongst those over 65 years-of-age.

These are two different ways the teams hope we can connect with our community through fun and fellowship and at the same time, get a better sense of whether this is how God is calling us to be in ministry. There's lots of excitement around these ideas, both from members of the team and others. When you're asked to help in some way, please prayerfully consider giving of your time and talents. It's a beautiful way to show your love and support for all the time and hard work the teams have devoted and to bless our communities.


