




It is a time for home.

Orange-Soaked Pound Cake

Ingredients:

1 package Betty Crocker pound cake mix Water & eggs as called for on cake mix package directions.

Directions:

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Bake pound cake as directed for 1 loaf pan. Cool 10 minutes. Remove from pan; cool about 30 minutes. Pierce with fork every ½ inch. Make Orange Glaze (below); pour slowly over warm cake, allowing some to drizzle down sides. Sprinkle with powdered sugar if Desired.

Orange Glaze

Ingredients:

½ cup powdered sugar
3 − 4 teaspoons orange juice
1/8 teaspoon grated orange peel

Directions:

Stir together powdered sugar, 3 teaspoons of the orange juice and the orange peel. Stir in just enough remaining orange juice to make glaze smooth and consistency of thick syrup.
